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Student Research Grants (SRG) Application – 2024

Part 3 of 3: Appraisal of Applicant

Evaluation of a SRG application relies heavily on the advisor's appraisal. Advisors should provide detailed information on (1) the student's ability to complete the proposed research as outlined in the application (2) significance of the research problem, and (3) potential for the student to make a continuing contribution to economic geology.

To maintain confidentiality, **do not** return the completed appraisal to the student applicant. Do not submit the <u>Application</u> (Part 2) with the <u>Appraisal of Applicant</u> (Part 3).
